



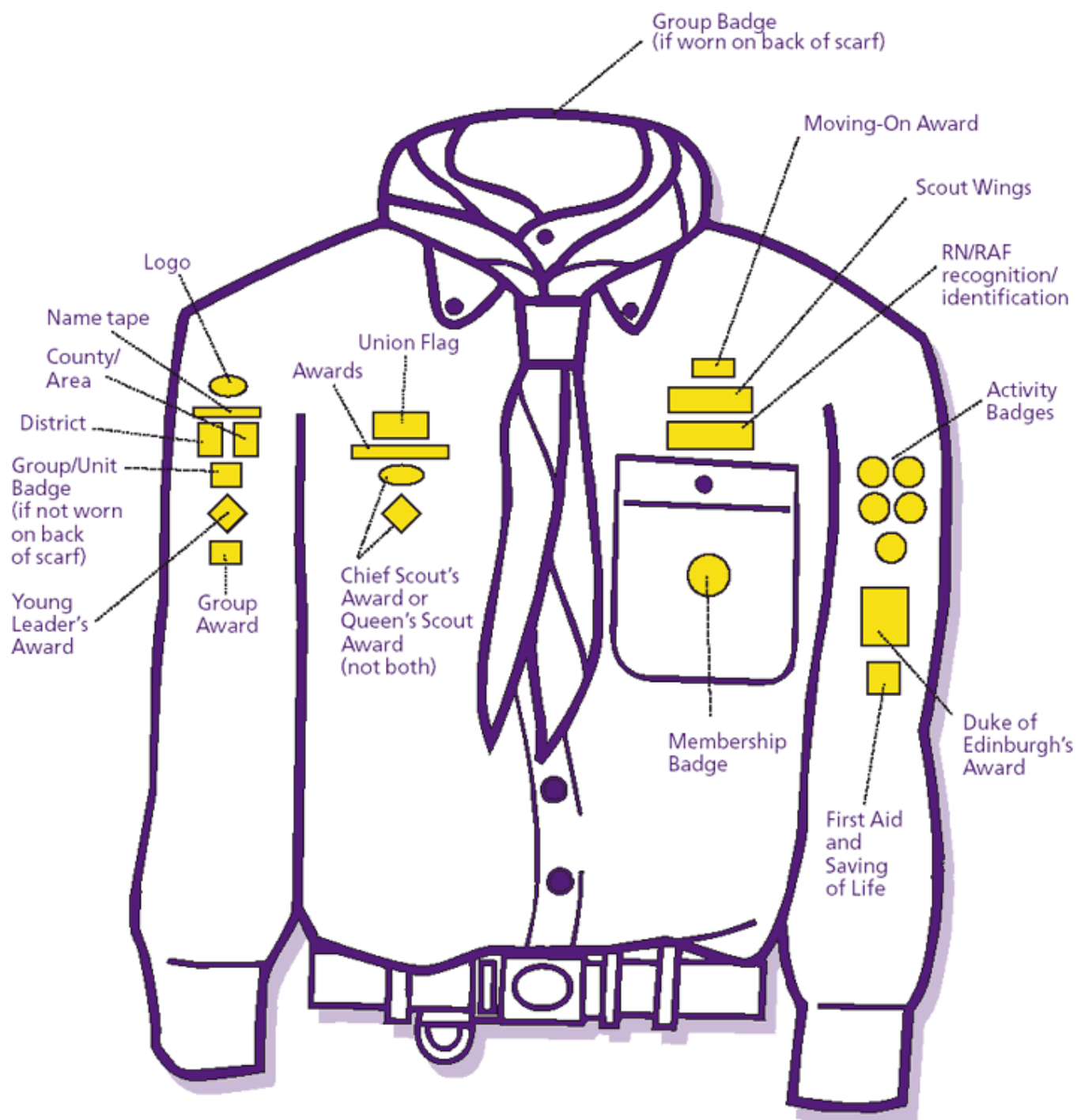
Explorer Scout Uniform Badge Positions

- ◆ The world badge must be placed, on the left side, in the centre, horizontally and vertically excluding the button band at the top, of the pocket.
- ◆ The top of the Union Flag badge should be on the right side 6.4 cm above a level line with the very top of the pocket.
- ◆ 1st Eccleshall Scout Group Badge is worn on the scarf.
- ◆ The Explorer unit badge is worn on the right shoulder below the district and county badges
- ◆ The column of badges on the right breast should be the same distance from the centre as on the left side (with the World badge). That is 13 cm from the line of the buttons on an adult size shirt
- ◆ All badges should be 1.2 cm apart
- ◆ Activity awards on the left arm must be in two vertical columns 1.2 cm apart starting 10.5 cm below the shoulder line.
- ◆ The moving on award should be 1.2 cm above the pocket but will need to be moved if you gain your Scout Wings
- ◆ The first aid and lifesaving badges of recognised organisations such as St John Ambulance are worn on the left forearm. Scout Emergency Aid stage activity awards are placed with other activity badges.

The centre line of all the badges is the tip of the arrowhead on the Scout Logo.

The County and District badges are 1.2 cm apart equally spaced either side of the centre line.

If this line measures 4cm long this diagram is actual size and can be used as a template.
